Nasal Flu Vaccination

Nasal Flu vaccine should not be administered to children with the following:

- Has received any other live-virus vaccines (MMR/Varicella) in the last 28 days
- Has Asthma or history of wheezing in the last year
- Severe allergy to eggs, egg protein, gentamicin, gelatin, or arginine
- Life-threatening reactions to influenza in the past
- Currently receiving aspirin or aspirin-containing therapy
- Prior history of Guillain-Barre Syndrome
- Has heart, lung, liver, kidney or metabolic disease (diabetes), or blood disorders
- Is pregnant or nursing
- Have a weakened immune system or going to be in contact with someone who has a severely weakened immune system.
- Is taking Tamiflu, Relenza, amantadine, or rimantadine
